SUBJECT: CANVASS MAY 4 GENERAL ELECTION

RECOMMENDATION:

Consider a resolution canvassing the City Election held on May 4, 2024 to elect the Mayor, City Council Place 1 and City Council Place 2; declaring the results; and take any necessary action.

BACKGROUND:

On May 4, the City of Grapevine held a General Election to elect a Mayor and City Council Members to Places 1 and 2. Early Voting took place from April 22 – April 30.

There are 35,392 registered voters in the City of Grapevine.

After the Early Voting Ballot Board meets, Tarrant County will provide the official results early next week. At the time, Resolution No. 2024-007 will be finalized and the final results and resolution will be provided to Council at the canvass on May 15.

As a result of the May 4, 2024 General Election, William D. Tate is declared duly elected as Mayor; Paul Slechta is declared duly elected to City Council, Place 1; and Sharron Rogers is declared duly elected to City Council, Place 2.

The swearing-in ceremony will take place prior to the Regular City Council meeting on May 21, 2024.
