

WATER CONSERVATION IS OUR RESPONSIBILITY

Drought conditions develop quickly & Unexpectedly.

Proper management of our water supply ensures the demand for water in our region.

YEAR-ROUND RESTRICTIONS

- ⤴ NO watering between the hours of **10am and 6pm**, Ever.
- ⤴ NO watering during freezing temperatures.

Stage 1 Drought Restrictions

- ⤴ **Mon** - NO Watering allowed.
- ⤴ **Tues & Fri** - Businesses only.
- ⤴ **Wed & Sat** - Resident home addresses ending in an even number (0, 2, 4, 6, 8)
- ⤴ **Thur & Sun** - Resident home addresses ending in an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, 9)
- ⤴ NO rinsing/washing of paved areas, buildings and windows.
- ⤴ NO draining and re-filling pools.
- ⤴ Vehicle washing limited to use of a bucket or hose with turnoff valve.

Stage 2 Drought Restrictions

- ⤴ Irrigation watering limited to once per week.
- ⤴ NO filling pools with automatic valves.
- ⤴ NO operating ornamental fountains or ponds that use potable water, except where necessary to support aquatic life, or are equipped with a recirculation system.

WATER CONSERVATION

Water Conservation benefits individual homeowners and our community as a whole.

- ⤴ Adjust your lawn mower cutting depth to the highest setting. Taller grass shades roots and holds soil moisture. Leaving grass clippings on the lawn adds nutrients back to the lawn.



- ⤴ Install a rain sensor to shut off your irrigation system during rain events.



- ⤴ Smartscape your lawn using plants native to our region. See: Texas Smartscape program.



Why conserve water? We need it! Conserving water saves you money! Conserving water will help make sure that there is water during dry years.
