

QUALIFICATIONS

CITY COUNCIL - Charter Section 3.02

Resident of Grapevine for at least six months preceding election
Registered voter of Texas
Not indebted to the City of Grapevine

The Home Rule Charter of the City of Grapevine, Texas, adopted November 16, 1965, establishes the following qualifications for members of the City Council:

Sec. 3.02. Qualifications

Each member of the City Council shall be a resident citizen of the City of Grapevine, shall be a qualified voter of the State of Texas, shall have been such resident citizen of the City of Grapevine for a period of not less than six (6) months immediately preceding his election, and shall not be indebted to the City of Grapevine.

If the Mayor or any Councilman fails to maintain the foregoing qualifications, or shall be absent from three consecutive regularly scheduled meetings without valid excuse, the City Council shall have the power and authority to declare, and may at its next regular meeting, declare a vacancy to exist; and, in such event, shall fill said vacancy, as set forth in Section 3.06 of this charter. If any member of the City Council announces his/her candidacy, or shall become in fact a candidate in any general, special or primary election for any office of profit or trust under the laws of this State or the United States other than the office then held, at any time when the unexpired term of the office then held shall exceed one (1) year, such announcement or such candidacy shall constitute an automatic resignation of the office then held.
