

City of Grapevine Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2021

The City of Grapevine purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 232,598 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas.

The City of Grapevine purchases electricity from Gexa Energy. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 25,703,780 kilowatt hours.

The City of Grapevine purchases electricity from CoServ Electric. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 46,363 kilowatt hours.

The City of Grapevine purchases electricity from Tri-County Electric. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 203,501 kilowatt hours.

The City of Grapevine purchases water from Trinity River Authority and is also a municipal water self-supplier, as well as, a municipal water provider. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased/consumed a total of 101,237,000 gallons of water.

The total cost for natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City of Grapevine in calendar year 2021 is \$4,355,896.
